- The Ladies World Championship will be limited to the best 8 pairs based on handicap. All matches will be best of 3 six game sets.

- All players are required to abide by the Rules of Real Tennis in Australia as well as those of the RMTC including the condition that all clothes worn on court are predominantly white.
